#### **Letter From the WACP President**

Dear colleagues,

In this short report, I would like to summarize the work and the activities of the World Association of Croatian Physicians in the year behind us.

The membership has increased to 420 members in the past year. We are especially pleased that a group of 30 Croatian physicians from Argentina has joined our Association.

As far as our active work in the last year is concerned, we have mostly been engaged in the preparation for our participation at the Croatian Physicians Association Assembly in Zadar. We have also been preparing the material which will be published in the Fifth Annual Report. The publishing should be completed before the next WACP Assembly.

We have also managed to insure hospital practice in Germany and the USA for four fellow physicians from Croatia.

I would like to use this opportunity to kindly ask both the colleagues willing and having the possibility to admit fellow physicians for a hospital practice, and the physicians willing to practice in Croatia, to contact us.

Three medical students were granted scholarships. The rewards for the best paper published in CMJ in 1995 were awarded as well. The fund raising for Croatian war orphans has been continued, so that we raised about DM70,000 in the last year.

The Association's treasury for 1995 was reviewed by the German Internal Revenue Service, and no irregularities were found.

Total income was DM40,071.62. The expenses were (in DM): bank expenses 875.30; telephone-fax 892.32; scholarships 3,000.00, hospital practice 430.97, congress contributions 1,000.00, equipment for Osijek 6,475.75, mail expenses 1,217.00, CMJ 6,000.00, Zlatni cekin (Gold Coin) activities 2,155.60, Croatian parliament 100.00, translations 1,000.00, rewards 1,000.00, solicitor 119.00. Total expenses (in DM) in 1995 amounted to 24,272.94, leaving the balance of 15,798.94.

As it was announced, our Fifth Assembly will be held from 8-10 May 1997 at the Ambassador Hotel in Opatija, Croatia. We have managed to insure the participation of 12 speakers from the world, as well as from our homeland. Istrian dinner is planned for May 8 and festive dinner for May 9. A boat excursion is scheduled for May 10. Other particulars will be proceeded in time.

We invite you to come to Opatija and hope to meet you in great number.
