

Supplementary Figure 3 – Differences between student groups (divided into quartiles based on their written partial exam score during continuous assessment: Q1, Q2, Q3 and Q4) in responses given to the questions pertaining to the number of hours spent studying during contact and on-line classes. The markers represent the difference between group means and the horizontal bars represent the 95% confidence interval (CI) for the difference between the group means calculated from Tukey's post-hoc test. The vertical dotted line represents a difference of 0 (no difference); if the 95% CI crosses the dotted line, the difference is not statistically significant. **(A)** Differences between groups means for the question pertaining to the number of hours spent studying Anatomy during contact classes (Question 8). **(B)** Differences between groups means for the question pertaining to the number of hours spent studying Anatomy during on-line classes (Question 9).
