Authorship	 Make authorship plan early in your research work. Discuss authorship with your supervisor and collaborators. Follow the ICMJE criteria, which are a standard in biomedical research. The article 20 of the MEFST Code of Ethics defines authorship: (3) Authors are all and only those who collaborated in the process of a scientific manuscript creation and who made a significant intellectual contribution according to the accepted international authorship criteria and take the public responsibility for the published work. (5) For election or re-election to research or research/teaching positions, the applicants must submit an authenticity statement that will confirm that each of their work or achievement they refer to is the original result of their work and that the said work does not contain other sources but those listed in the publication.
