Principles of visceral systems

GENERAL OBJECTIVES:

Using examples of solid and hollow visceral organs, distinguish:

Hollow organs: beginning, termination, connections to other organs, description of walls/cavity, surfaces, borders, relations to serous membranes and mesenteries, supply

Solid (glandular) organs: surfaces, borders, poles, hilus, segmentation (lobes, segments, lobules), relations to serous membranes and mesenteries, blood and nervous supply.
