1. Go to An@tomedia, **thorax, abdomen and pelvis** modules-regions-frames: **01 to 08 for thorax, 01 to 06 for abdomen and 01 to 06 for pelvis**

-Click on <u>underlined text</u> to identify the composition of thoracic, abdominal and pelvic walls

-Activate 'can you identify' visualize walls/boundaries and contents of the body walls

Innervation of thoracic, abdominal and pelvic walls and viscera

2. Go to An@tomedia, **thorax, abdomen and pelvis** modules-systems-frames: **23-24 for thorax, 26-27 for abdomen and 31-33 for pelvis**

-Click on <u>underlined text</u> to identify composition of thoracic, abdominal and pelvic somatic and visceral innervations

-Activate 'can you identify' to visualize anatomic components of the somatic and visceral innervation

Lymph drainage of thoracic, abdominal and pelvic walls and viscera

2. Go to An@tomedia, **thorax**, **abdomen and pelvis** modules-systems-frames: **35-37** for **thorax**, **32-33** for abdomen and **36** for pelvis

-Click on <u>underlined text</u> to identify composition of thoracic, abdominal and pelvic lymphatics

-Activate 'can you identify' to visualize anatomic components of the lymphatic circulation in trunk regions
