Topics for the debate: Abortion prohibition, Euthanasia legalisation, Individualised health insurance, Body farms for (self-)organ harvesting, Mandatory COVID vaccination, Regulating food industry, Designer babies. Topics will be assigned alphabetically during classes. Students work in pairs (dedicated time for preparation of cases and presentations assigned on Thursday). Students are scored during debate, according to three criteria: a) clarity, b) use of arguments and research evidence, and c) rebuttal. Each point can only be assigned to one team. Points from the debate are transferred to the exam scores, as additional points (up to three points may be awarded in this way).
