## **IMPORTANT NOTES FOR STUDENTS:**

- Attendance at seminars and practicals is MANDATORY. Absence from seminars and practicals (due to a valid reason, with a medical certificate, up to 20% of the total number of hours at most) must be made up and the corresponding material will be examined by oral colloquium. Students who do not pass colloquium from the seminars and practicals they missed will not have the opportunity to take the partial exam.
- 2. Students should study the teaching material from seminars and practicals in detail before starting them. During the practicals and seminars, the teachers will check the preparedness of the students either **orally or in writing**. Students not prepared for practicals will not be able to attend practical classes.
- 3. Students must wear the prescribed laboratory clothes to the practicals (they WILL NOT be able to access the practicals without a **lab coat**). Also, students must bring an practical manual (can be obtained in the print store of the School of Medicine), writing utensils and a calculator to the practicals.
- 4. Students are assigned to **practical groups** and should adhere to the planned schedule. EXCEPTIONALLY, in agreement with the leader of practicals, students can change the practical group.
