Description:

Ovid offers a single online destination for seamlessly accessing and working with databases from the world's leading biomedical information providers. The Ovid platform hosts **Ovid MEDLINE** as well as **EBMR**, Ovid's collection of databases devoted to evidence-based medical practice. This training course will review the type of documents retrievable from these databases; from bibliographic references to journal articles all the way to full-text systematic reviews. The course will also cover the various ways documents can be searched for. These include the **Find Citation Search**, **Multi-Field Search**, **Advanced Search** and **Basic Search**, Ovid's natural language search option. The training session will also cover document view and export options and conclude with a review of **My Workspace**. This is a user-specific, personalised space within Ovid that enables users to store the results of their searches along with their own documents in a variety of formats, such as Word, PowerPoint or PDF files. My Workspace also enables users to save their individual search histories. These in turn can also be set up as **Auto-Alerts** which will run automatically at a time interval set by the user and where the results are then sent to a location of the user's choice, be it at e-mail address or a **My Projects** folder in My Workspace.
