Who can apply?

Applicants must be registered for a scientific master's programme in an EMBL member or prospect member state eligible for EU Widening Actions under Horizon 2020. These are:

• Croatia | Czech Republic | Estonia | Hungary Latvia | Lithuania | Luxembourg | Malta Montenegro | Poland | Portugal | Slovakia

Applicants can be from any field, but should be interested in pursuing an interdisciplinary PhD in the life sciences, or continuing their career in life science-related professions.

Applicants must be available to attend:

- A workshop on 6 December 2022.
- The EMBL PhD Symposium (7–9 December 2022).

What selected candidates can expect

From informal mentoring:

- You will meet your mentor during a mentoring workshop on 6 December 2022.
- You will then interact for 18 months. The focus of mentoring will be mutually decided by you and your mentor, and mentoring will take place mainly by video call.
- The mentors are postdocs working on interdisciplinary projects, who are part of the EIPOD4 programme.

The EMBL PhD Symposium, "The Spectra of Life", is a scientific conference organised by EMBL PhD students. It offers a programme of talks that provide glimpses into a range of life science research, as well as opportunities to network with PhD students and more established scientists.
