





PLATBIOMED's objective is to resolve the interoperability issues between the different sectors of health by designing a platform for benchmarking the tools and standards available to professionals across the silos that interpret distinct levels of data (from OMIC level data to tissue organ data to individual personalised data and finally to the public health data). The ultimate objective of this platform is to break silos that remain barriers to the implementation of new health policies.
